
LUNAR NEW YEAR BOOK SUGGESTIONS

Check out some of our recomendations for books that can help everyone learn more about Lunar New Year celebrations!




FRIENDS ARE FRIENDS, FOREVER BY DANE LIU, ILLUS. BY LYNN SCURFIELD


RUBY'S CHINESE NEW YEAR BY VICKIE LEE, ILLUS. BY JOEY CHOU
